ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Entry fee per item: \$5
2. Entry Deadline is September 11, 2007. All forms must be received by this date for eligibility. Entry form may be downloaded from Great Lakes Rabbit & Cavy Shows website. The Art and Craft entries are not to be included with the regular rabbit/cavy entry.

3. If the artwork is to be transported home by someone other than the Exhibitor, written consent must be included with the entry and specific Identification designate must be included.
4. Any artwork left in the showroom after the conclusion of the 2007 ARBA Convention will become property of GLRCS.
5. Check in: Entries must be in place by 6:00 pm Sunday October 14, 2007.
6. Winners will be announced Monday, October 15, 2007.

ELIGIBILITY

All artwork must include a rabbit/cavy in the subject matter. Works must be original and completed after November 2, 2006.

SPECIFICATIONS

All entries must be ready for display. Works to be hung must be ready for hanging with wire in place. Artwork must be able to fit through a standard door. Three dimensional works may not exceed 60 lbs.

PUBLICITY

Signature on the entry form grants the sponsors the right to photograph exhibited work for publicity, educational and publication purposes.



SALE OF ART

Sales will be encouraged. The GLRCS will handle all sales and collect a 15% commission on all artwork sold as a result of the exhibition. All proceeds going to the Scholarship Fund. The artist must label all works with the price or a note that the item is not for sale.

Sale cards will be available in the showroom and will be placed on the item after the judging has been completed.

AGREEMENT

Submitting an entry form to the exhibition constitutes an agreement on the part of the artist with all conditions in the prospectus. No work displayed may be withdrawn before the close of the exhibition. The sponsors reserve the right to reproduce entries for publicity purpose and in future publications related to ARBA or Great Lakes Rabbit & Cavy Shows Inc.

LIABILITY

All reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure protection of submitted work upon receipt at the National ARBA Art Show. Neither ARBA nor GLRCS will be responsible for loss or damage of any item entered.
